### **Day 2: Examine the Passage**

What is this passage about?

If I were to give this section a heading or title, what would it be?  
How would I summarize or restate this section to someone else?  
Can I see how this section "fits" with what comes before and after it?  
What's the main idea of this section?

### **Day 3: Apply the Passage**

What do I do with it? (Application)

Is there a:

- Sin to Confess?
- Promise to Claim?
- Action to Avoid?
- Command to Obey?
- Example to Follow?
